She is bringing info to Constable and then will address WEM. Signage regarding EPS monitoring in Donsdale. No one is looking to repair fencing (Westgate or WEM)? Can this be addressed? Requesting an intentional opening, WEM had promised to open up a space to deter the vandalism.
